Registration fee includes lodging and meals. Six buffet meals provided; dinner on Friday, breakfast, lunch, and dinner on Saturday, and breakfast and lunch on Sunday in one of the dining rooms. ID card, upon check-in at Reiber Hall, allows admission to your dorm room, dining hall, and certain recreational facilities.
